| Portable Suction Unit | Medium | Immediate life support Via company initially |
| Vascular Doppler | Medium | Specific TVN |
| Carbon Monoxide Analyser | Low | Smoking cessation |
| Electric Beds | Low | Via company initially |
| Electronic Thermometer | Low | Foundation physical health skills |
| Nebuliser | Low | Local arrangements In house training |
| Ophthalmoscope | Low | Medical training |
| Peak Flow Meters | Low | Local arrangements In house training |
| Pulse Oximeter | Low | PMVA |
| Scales | Low | Local arrangements In house training |
| Sphygmomanometer | Low | Foundation physical health skills |

Each medical device on the above list has been assessed and given a rating according to their risk.

The above list includes devices which would be found in the majority of wards/departments.

Some areas will have specialised devices which will only be in use within their given area. Local arrangements must be in place for staff to receive training.
