

What GDPR will mean for you as a member of our NHS Foundation Trust?

On 25 May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force which replaced the previous Data Protection Act (1998). The benefits of the GDPR is that we all have more say over what organisations can do with our personal data.

Under GDPR, NTW will continue to hold some personal information about you as a member (such as your name and address). Your membership is important to us as it helps us to fulfil our legal obligation, which requires us to maintain a membership of the Trust representative of the people we serve and allows us to run elections for Trust Governors.

As a member, you can help us shape our services, keep on top of the latest news, elect a Governor and stand as a Governor yourself.

To keep you updated, we will periodically communicate with you regarding important changes, events, elections and information that we hope you will find interesting and of value.

The data we hold on you in relation to your membership is kept securely and only used in connection with your membership. If you would like to review the data we hold on you or make any changes please contact us at CorporateAffairs@ntw.nhs.uk or telephone: 0191 245 6827.
