To care for those who once cared for us is one of the highest honours



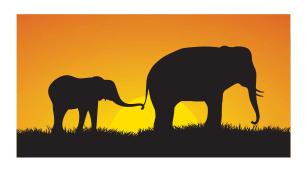
To love a person is to learn the song that is in their heart and sign it to them when they have forgotten





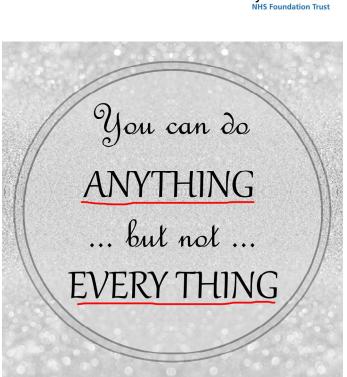


It hurts to know you'll never remember the things we will never forget
