## Apprenticeships

- **On-the-job** working and learning experience
- **Off-the-job** academic learning and tutoring
- Opportunity of **Networking** with those on programme and in the same job role
- **Your career begins** as soon as you start an apprenticeship



## Traditional University:



- Temporary **on-the-job** experience
- A main focus on **academic learning**
- **Socialise** with fellow University students
- Develop a range of **transferable skills** to be ready for a career

## Finance:

- **Full funded** via the organisation's 'Apprenticeship Levy'
- **Earn your wage:**
  - 1st year annual salary: £18,005
  - 2nd - 5th year annual salary: £19,737



- Total programme fees to **pay back:** £27,750
- Apply for an **annual Bursary** of £6000 per year

## Outcome:

- A broad understanding from **academic study** and a range of skills following **work experience in work placements**
- Completion of a **Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship** to incorporate a **BSc (Hons) degree**.
- **Guaranteed employment** into a Registered Nurse role upon completion
