


Communication Top Tips

Use these Top Tips at home to support your child's communication!

- 1. Keep language simple use short sentences and familiar words.
- 2. Give one instruction at a time.
- Slow down.
- 4. Make sure what you say matches the way you say it.
- 5. Remember your child's level of understanding.
- 6. Get down to your child's level.
- 7. Accept and value all forms of communication as equally important e.g. pointing is valued the same as speech.
- 8. Use visual supports e.g. symbols, photos, objects, and sign.

- 9. Model different methods of communication you need to teach the system!
- 10. Show your child what you are talking about.
- 11. Remember behaviour can be a form of communication.
- 12. Give your child time to get their message across.
- 13. Means, Reasons and Opportunities! Create the opportunities for communication.
- 14. Communication needs to be all day, every day.



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
