Apprenticeships

- **On-the-job** working and learning experience

Traditional University:



- Temporary **on-the-job** experience
- A main focus on **academic learning**

Finance:

- **Full funded** via the organisation's 'Apprenticeship Levy'

- **Earn your wage:**
 - 1st year annual salary: £22,383
 - 2nd - 5th year annual salary: £22,816 - £24,336



- Total programme/loan fees to **pay back**: £27,750 (at least).

- Apply for an **annual Bursary** of £6000 per year

Outcome:

- A broad understanding from **academic study** and a range of skills following **work experience in work placements**

- Completion of a **Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship** to incorporate a **BSc (Hons) degree**.

- **Guaranteed employment** into a Registered Nurse role upon completion



- Thorough **knowledge** in a particular subject

- Completion of a **BSc (Hons) degree**.

- **External applicant** when applying for jobs
